



General Information

History

Turning Point Christian Academy was officially opened on November 6, 2006, as a ministry of Turning Point at Calvary. The school was lead by Mrs. Carole Felten (director) and two staff members, 1 teacher and 1 aide. The school consisted of one preschool class of three and four year olds, and an afterschool program that picked up students from Mill Creek Elementary School.

The school quickly grew and had an open enrollment of approximately 150 students for the 2007/2008 school year. The school also opened the elementary department with a kindergarten class.

Christian Education

Christian Education is taught each day as the first school subject. In addition to a formal Bible class that teaches basic knowledge of both the Old and New Testament, TPCA uses a Christ-centered curriculum that has a Biblical world view. All students participate in a weekly chapel to encourage corporate worship.

Lunches

All students are required to provide their own lunches.

Staff

TPCA complies with all of the standards put forth by the state of Florida. Its operation is governed by the pastor of Turning Point at Calvary, a volunteer school board, and a paid director/administrator. All VPK teachers are required to currently have a CDA or CDAE degree. All teachers in the elementary department are trained and certified to teach elementary students and have at least a BA or BS degree.

Uniforms

Uniforms are encouraged for students in the preschool department, and required for all students in the elementary department. Uniforms may be obtained at Logomotion in St. Augustine. See the school office for more information.
